PROPOSED WITHDRAWAL OF EXTRAORDINARY RESOLUTIONS AT THE EGM

Cambridge Industrial Trust Management Limited, as manager (the "Manager") of Cambridge Industrial Trust ("CIT"), refers to the Notice of Extraordinary General Meeting ("EGM") and Circular both dated 25 March 2013 in relation to the EGM scheduled on 19 April 2013 for the purposes of seeking Unitholders' approval of the resolutions relating to the Proposed Unit Issue Supplement to the Trust Deed, the Proposed Development Management Fee Supplement to the Trust Deed and the Proposed Performance Fee Supplement to the Trust Deed (collectively, the "Extraordinary Resolutions").

Words and expressions used in this announcement bear the meanings as set out in the Circular.

After assessing the level of support from Unitholders for the Extraordinary Resolutions todate, the Manager is of the view that the Extraordinary Resolutions are unlikely to be carried at the EGM. In light of this, the Manager intends to advise the Chairman of the EGM that the Extraordinary Resolutions be withdrawn at the EGM.
